Eph 4:16 42	If the Lord confirms the hopes (dreams) of 3 church members, keep those people's hopes up until the things are accomplished. Heb 10:23 59	After ridding yourselves of the love of money, serve a simple meal and set an example for a family that seems to put too much value on money. Heb 13:5 64	Entertain and strengthen the faith of someone who has not been to church for a long while. Heb 3:12 35	<b>5</b>
<b>6</b>	Adopt three church families to pray for this month. Call them and get their prayer requests. Pray for them at least three times a week. 2 Cor 1:8-11 57	Carry out a plan to make certain your loved ones and neighbors hear the gospel of Jesus Christ. Partner in prayer with another church family. Matt 5:14-16 47	Meeting with another church family, discuss and identify ways to address compromising situations with non-believing friends.
